This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on this 17... day of the month of January in the year 2023. by and between the **Janta College Bakewar (Etawah)** [First party] and the **Tally Education Pvt. Ltd.** [Second party].


The parties, having discussed fields of Industrial Training/Seminar/Workshop/Skill Development Programme and allied activities between the two institutions have decided to enter into long term collaboration for promotion of students' training and quality enhancement in postgraduate research in cutting edge areas or as revised from time to time.

WHEREAS, It has been considered expedient to agree in writing to participate jointly in the projects requiring expertise and logistics from both the parties.

The Tally Education Pvt. Ltd. considers this as an opportunity for selected students' to training and quality enhancement with additional knowledge and skill development.

Janta College, Bakewar (Etawah) considers this as an opportunity to benefit from the knowledge and skills of qualified and motivated recent experts, whose academic studies are relevant to its fields of work and practical experience required to excel in research and development.

Article 1: Scope


- 1.1 The First party will recognize the Second party as an Institute for conducting Internship/Skill development programme/ Industrial training/ Survey work etc. The First party will recognize experts of the The Tally Education Pvt. Ltd. for guiding students working for the said Training and others.
- 1.2 Operational details of working with accounting/taxation effort and collaboration will be made in common Training programmes and/or projects/ Internship/Skill development programme/ Industrial training/ Survey work etc. restricted to specific mandated domain within the approved disciplines/divisions.
- 1.3 Training, instrumentation facility and library facilities available with the First party and the Second party will be made available to the faculty and Trainee's. However, the costs of specific consumables will be borne by the respective organizations.
- 1.4 There shall be an exchange of students for academic and Professional training purposes. Accommodation in the Hostel shall be arranged, wherever possible, as per extant rates. The duration of exchange visits will be determined by mutual consent between both the parties.


Article 2: Management

- 2.1 Principal of the First party and Director of the Second party will be responsible to work out operational details of co-operation between the two organizations and ensure proper and effective implementation of this MoU.
- 2.2 The Second party will provide free accommodation to the students if required during their for training, skill development, programme.
- 2.3 The Second party will also provide free Medical facilities if required to the students during their stay in training work.
- 2.4 The Advisory Committee will meet at least once in a year alternatively in the institutions of the First party and the Second party to review the activities. This meeting shall include presentation on the academic and Professional Training, which should be open to the students, faculty and other learner's.

Article 3: Exchange of Information

- 3.1 The term "information" includes training of practical knowledge of accounting and taxation, and other information intended to be provided, exchanged, or arising under Training programmes and/or projects/ Internship/Skill development programme/ Industrial training/ Survey work etc, entered into pursuant to this MoU.
- 3.2 The parties support the widest possible dissemination of information. Each party in joint Training programmes shall be given the right to use, disclose, publish or disseminate such information for any and all purposes.


Article 4.: General Provisions

- 4.1 It is understood that the First party and the Second party subscribe to the principle of equal opportunity and do not discriminate on the basis of race, sex, age, caste or religion. Both the Institutions shall abide by these principles in the administration of this agreement and neither party shall impose criteria for exchange of scholars or students, which violate principles of non-discrimination.
- 4.2 Both parties understand that all financial agreements will have to be negotiated separately and will depend on the availability of funds.
- 4.3 Both parties acknowledge that exchange of students from one party to the other shall be subject to the availability of funds and shall comply with the regulations and policies of the First party and the Second party.
- 4.4 All questions related to this MoU arising during its term will be settled by the parties by mutual agreement. Disagreements at the operating level shall be forwarded to respective higher officials for appropriate resolution failing which an arbitrator of mutual acceptance may be identified for the settlement of dispute, if any.
- 4.5 All questions not foreseen related to this MoU will be handled by the parties by mutual agreement.
- 4.6 Nothing in this MoU is intended to affect other cooperation or collaborations between the parties.

Article 5: Admission and Fees

- 5.1 Admission of the students and the award of Certificate for different programmes will be the responsibility of the Second party as per the rules and regulations.
- 5.2 Allotment of the students will be done by the approval of Principal of the First party and Director of the Second party.
- 5.3 The First party would have the right to screen the student's eligibility for admission based on their academic period.
- 5.4 Second party shall decide the location and sharing quantum of Training work with the consultation of "Industrial Academic Integration, Skill Development and Employment cell" of the College (First party).
- 5.5 The number of student(s) at any particular time will be subjected to the availability of Training facilities at the both party.
- 5.6 Any student(s) admitted to the Second party for Training programmes and/or projects/ Internship/Skill development programme/ Industrial training/ Survey work etc, if found violating the rules and regulations laid down by the Second party or indulge in such activities that amount to tarnishing the image of the Institute, or cause damage to the property, the registration of such student(s) would be summarily terminated. The First party will not complete the formalities of issuing the certificates to such students until they compensate the losses to the Second party.


Article 6: Entry into effect, modification and termination


- 6.1 This MoU shall become effective on the date it is signed by the parties and shall be valid for one year extendable up to five years. Both parties shall review the status of the MoU at the end of each year period to determine any modification, whenever necessary. The period of validity of this MoU may be extended by mutual consent up to five years. This MoU may be amended by mutual written agreement and may be terminated at any time by either party upon written notification signed by the competent authority of the party initiating termination. Such notification must be given to the other party at least six months in advance from the effective date of termination.
- 6.2 All joint activities not completed at the expiration or termination of the MoU may be continued until their completion under the terms of this MoU.
- 6.3 No amendment or modification of the MoU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the parties or their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to be amendment of the MoU. The modifications/changes shall become part of the MoU and shall be effective from the date on which they are made/executed, unless otherwise agreed to.


This MoU has been executed in two originals, one of which has been retained by the First party and the other by the Second party.
